Do state and affirm that I am the legally authorized guardian of the above-named child, and I/we also give permission for her/him to travel with the Willamette Girlchoir to all events scheduled by the Girlchoir, including concert tours and various locations within the United States.

I/We also hereby give the adult staff and chaperones of the Girlchoir permission to authorize medical treatment for my/our daughter/son named above, as they deem necessary without additional permission from me/us. I/We agree to assume responsibility for all costs advanced by the Girlchoir in order to obtain medical care for my/our daughter.

In the event that the adult representatives of the Girlchoir decide that my/our daughter must leave an event for medical or other unforeseen reasons, I/we agree to be responsible for any costs related to her return trip home separate from the tour. I/We understand such a decision is solely at the discretion of the adult representative of the Girlchoir.

In return for the Girlchoir allowing my/our child to participate in concert tours and other events sponsored by the Girlchoir, I/We agree to release the Willamette Girlchoir, its directors, agents, and employees from all actions, causes of action, damages, claims or demands, which the undersigned or said child, or any successors may have against the Girlchoir, or such other parties, for all personal injuries, property damage or other types of loss or damage of any kind, whether or not presently known or contemplated, which may occur during a tour, including transportation to and from. Each person signing below acknowledges having read this release and understanding all its terms and their significance, and that this release is executed voluntarily.

This permission and release form will remain in effect until the above-named child no longer participates in the Girlchoir, or I/We notify the Girlchoir in writing of the withdrawal of our permission and release.
